The 2017-2018 year was an extremely successful one for the Sylacauga High School Band Program! In the fall, the SHS Marching "Aggie" Band (MAB) performed their production, "This is it!", at two marching competitions. On September 30, 2017, the SHS MAB attended Mid-South Competition in Gadsden, AL and received the following awards: Drum Major - 1; Majorettes - 1; Color Guard - 2; Percussion - 1; Band - 1 1 1 for overall 1. Two weeks later, we attended Troy's Southeastern States Marching Competition where we received the following awards: Drum Major - 1; Majorettes - 1; Color Guard - 1; Percussion - 1; Band - 1 2 1 for overall 1.

In the spring, we had enough students to fill a concert band ensemble and participate at Music Performance Assessment (MPA) at the end of February. We learned our program and received the following ratings: On-stage: 1 1 1; Sight-reading - 1. We received Superior ratings in every area. Our Spring Percussion and Jazz Concert and Spring Band Concert were a big hit as we featured our MPA pieces and cinema music magic!

Our 2018-2019 production is title: "On Broadway." We will be taking a musical journey from Broadway Avenue in Sylacauga, Alabama to Broadway Street in New York City, New York! The SHS MAB will also be traveling to perform in New York City in April 2019! It is going to be an exciting year! We hope to see you this fall...especially at Alumni night!
